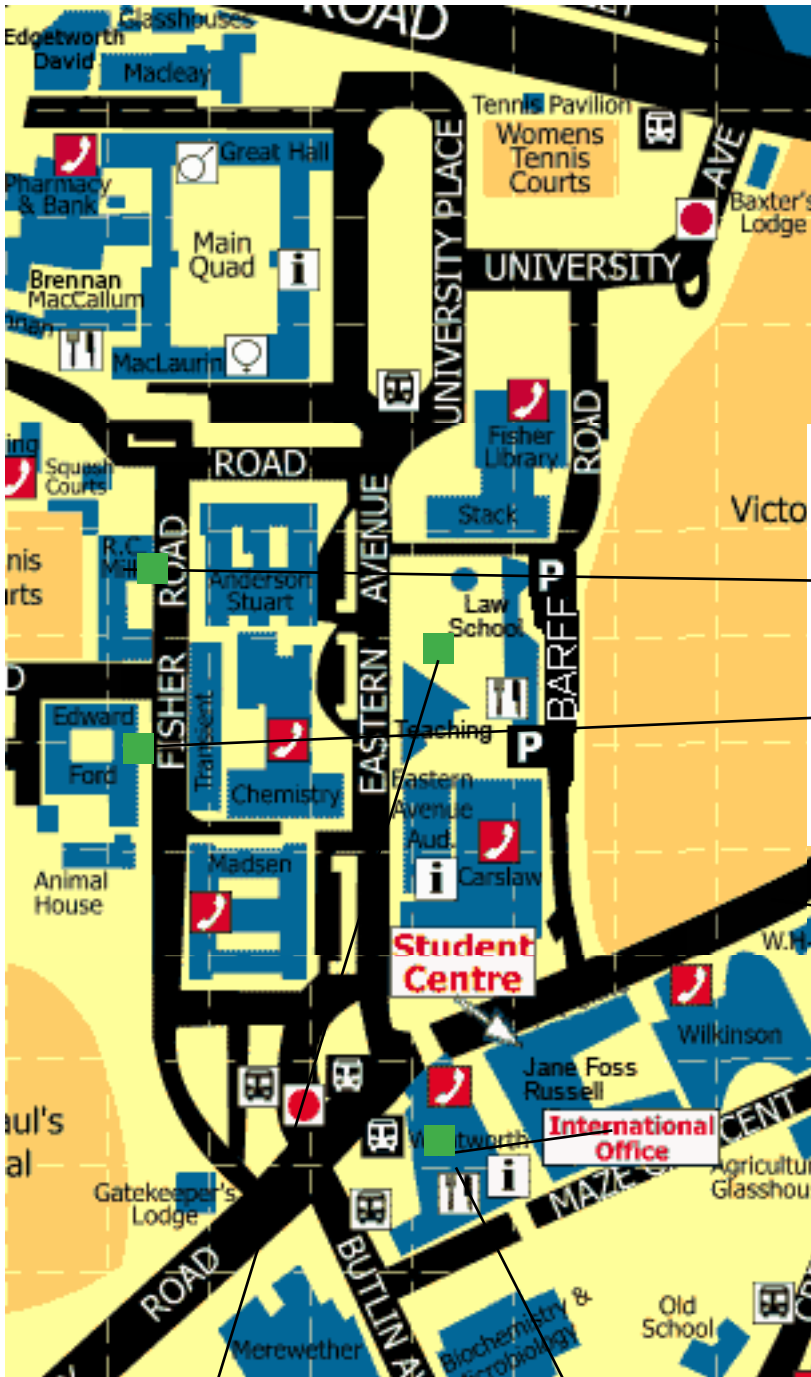

The Edward Ford Building is in Fisher Road, on the corner of Physics Road (entrance in Fisher Road. Note - the photo below is bizarre as it is not round!

When you enter the building you will find yourself in a foyer (see photo below, facing out rather than in). There is a sign straight ahead (above) to the Margaret Oldfield Lecture Theatre (more of a room in fact) - follow the signs from thereon.





PARRAMATTA ROAD

Turn left into University Avenue (Main entrance to University) from the city (no right turn from west). Follow road, which will take you into Manning Road, turn left into Fisher Road, pass Physics Road on right, and Edward Ford is next building on your right.
